Yeşilova is one of the oldest settlements of Burdur. During the excavations carried out in Dereköy and Gencali within the borders of the district, sherds belonging to the Chalcolithic Period (5,000 BC) were found. The region came under the domination of the Turkish Beys right after the 1071 Malazgirt Victory. Yeşilova, which joined the Ottomans in the 15th century, was a township under the name of Eski Erle. In 1936, its name was changed from Erle to Yeşilova and became a district of Burdur. Its current population is 15,071.

In addition to agriculture and animal breeding, aromatic plants, especially rose and lavender, are widely grown in Yeşilova.
